Luke 2:20

I. The shepherd’s response to the Gospel message from the angels:

- They _____ . “Let us go to Bethlehem and see...”
- The message was _____ to them. The message led them to take action
- They told _____. Why? It was all true and very good news for all.
- They glorified and praised God.

II. To Glorify and Praise...

- doxazo – to praise, to magnify, to celebrate, to give honor, to make renown (the “Doxology” – “Praise God from whom all blessings flow...”)
- By believing and taking action and telling others... they were saying and showing “these events and people are real and _____ to me.” *Telling others*
- aineo – to extol, to sing praises in honor of God, to recommend, to promise
- Telling God _____ that what is happening is wonderful.
- *Talking to God, “What are doing in my life is very good.”*

II. “Glorifying and praising God”

- The shepherds took no _____ for themselves. Everything that was happening was the goodness and love of God.
