Luke 2:20
I. The shepherd's response to the Gospel message from the angels:
- They "Let us go to Bethlehem and see…"
- The message was to them. The message led them to take action
- They told Why? It was all true and very good news for all.
- They glorified and praised God.
II. To Glorify and Praise
 <u>doxazo</u> – to praise, to magnify, to celebrate, to give honor, to make renown (the "Doxology" – "Praise God from whom all blessings flow")
- By believing and taking action and telling others they were saying and showing
"these events and people are real and to me." Telling others
- <u>aineo</u> – to extol, to sing praises in honor of God, to recommend, to promise
- Telling God that what is happening is wonderful.
- Talking to God, "What are doing in my life is very good."
II. "Glorifying and praising God"
- The shepherds took no for themselves. Everything that was
happening was the goodness and love of God.
Praise God from whom all blessings flow; Praise Him, all creatures here below; Praise Him above, ye heavenly host: praise Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Amen.
