

Sermon Notes – May 21 – Jesus Prays for Us, His Church  
John 17:8-11 (Acts 1:21-26 and 1 Peter 4:12-5:11)

1. Jesus prayed that He gave His followers the Father's \_\_\_\_\_

- Miracles without correct teaching easily \_\_\_\_\_
- Without correct teaching that He was the \_\_\_\_\_ ,  
and what the Kingdom of God was about, and the truth of the Old Testament  
prophets His suffering, death and resurrection would not be \_\_\_\_\_

2. The promises of God to save were \_\_\_\_\_ in Jesus' suffering, death and resurrection.

- Jesus came to do what God planned. What happened to Jesus was not surprising to Him or to the Father or to the Holy Spirit. The plans to save God's people were made before earth was even created. (Eph. 2:3-5)

3. Jesus prays for His \_\_\_\_\_ , not the world.
