Sermon Notes (Dec. 17) "Die Grundstimmung des Christen" Three Foundational Sentiments of the Christian Joy – Prayer – Thanksgiving 1 Thessalonians 5:16-24

(Note: The German "die Grundstimmung des Christian" is the term used by Dr. R.C.H. Lenski, a well known Lutheran New Testament scholar. Lenski wrote that "the trio belongs together: joy-prayer-thanks, these three are well called die Grundstimmung des Christen."

There are a variety of translations for this term <i>Grundstimmung</i> , "prevailing mood, atmosphere, basic mood, underlying sentiment, undertone, overall atmosphere, fundamental mood, general sentiment, etc."

In everything giving

- Again, no condition is required to give thanks. All conditions are included.
- Giving thanks "in connection with everything." Acts 4:1-31; 5:17-42 and when they had called in the apostles, they beat them and charged them not to speak in the name of Jesus, and let them go. Then they left the presence of the council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to suffer dishonor for the name. And every day, in the temple and from house to house, they did not cease teaching and preaching that the Christ is Jesus. Acts 5:38-4
